

Yr 10 Battlefields Letter Feb 2019

Dear Parent / Guardian,

At this point in the year, we would like to provide you with some updated information about the trip to the battlefields of WW1 and Paris.

We will depart from school on Thursday 20th June in the afternoon and return on Wednesday 26th June. The total cost for the trip was £800 and the following instalments should have been handed in by now:

Week beginning: 14th May 2018 -£150/£100 (2nd Deposit), 10th September 2018 - £200, 12th November 2018 - £100

There are still two instalments left to pay on the following dates:

20th - 27th February 2019 - £100

Week beginning - 8th April 2019 - £150

If there are any difficulties with these instalments or if you would prefer to pay more or less at a certain time, please do not hesitate to contact us.

Further details about the trip including specifics about travel times, hotels and the itinerary will be published nearer to departure which allows us to be as accurate with that as possible. An information meeting for parents and pupils will be held in school shortly before the trip departs.

In the meantime, we would ask that you check that passports are up to date and valid for up to six months after the date of return (June 2019). Although this six month period is not a current requirement, travel companies are advising this precaution as a result of the continuing uncertainty regarding Brexit. If necessary, it is advisable to renew passports well in advance as there is often a significant waiting period.

Please also ensure that your child is in possession of a valid European Health Insurance Card which enables them to receive free medical treatment abroad. This is free and can be applied for online.

To assist with flight confirmation, we will be collecting a photocopy of passports with the next instalment in February. This photocopy should be brought with the instalment to the Green Room between 8:30am-8:55am. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you have any queries or concerns.
