· Identify Note letter names (lines and spaces)

· Identify the names and meanings of all the <b>elements of music</b> , as they will appear in the listening questions.  eg Describe the <b>tempo</b> of this music.		
· Listen to the instruments of the orchestra at <a href="https://philharmonia.co.uk/resources/instruments/">https://philharmonia.co.uk/resources/instruments/</a> to help you with general listening.		
· Recognise Beat in the bar; · Recognise pitched and un-pitched Ostinati and which instruments are playing them		
· Recognise the meaning and use of Motif and Pentatonic Scale		
· Be able to identify structure/form in a piece of music using the letters A, B, C, etc for the different sections as they come along or repeat.		
· Practise my ukulele test piece through steadily, without stopping and without making a mistake. <i>It does not have to be played fast, but smoothly and accurately.</i> The test piece on Ukulele is Swing Low.
