Careers Education Programme

All pupils in Year 10 have a period of time-tabled Careers Education per fortnight.

Lessons include the following topics:

- Investigation of a variety of both familiar and unfamiliar jobs
- Identifying the skills associated with entry to particular career paths
- Exploring the changing concept of a career
- Self-assessment of Employability Skills, personal interests, balance of intelligences, personal style etc.
- Interview with a family member
- Questions to ask at a Careers Convention
- Research using local university and further education college prospectuses
- Labour Market Information
- STEM Focus
- Exploration of Job Families
- Introduction to CVs

Advice & Guidance

All pupils in Year 10 have at least two one-to-one guidance interviews with their Careers Tutor to assist with GCSE Subject Choice options. In January pupils receive a Subject Choice Booklet and attend a talk on GCSE Subject Choices and "New Subjects."
