



## Summer 2021 Revision Check List

Listening, Reading and Writing skills will be assessed. Each skill has equal weighting.



### Listening

The Listening skill exam will take place during a class before the start of the school exams. You will have to do a range of exercises including multiple choice, true or false, matching pairs, ticking boxes, filling in grids, giving information in English etc. For this skill you will need to **recognise** spoken French and communicate your understanding and recognition of it.



### Reading

Your reading skills will be assessed as part of the timetabled exams. You will have to do a range of exercises including multiple choice, true or false, matching pairs, ticking boxes, filling in grids, giving information in English etc. For this skill you will need to **recognise** written French and communicate your understanding and recognition of it.



### Writing

Your writing skills will be assessed as part of the timetabled exams. You will have to write sentences in French for headings provided and write a longer paragraph. You need to be able to **use** and write your French accurately.

You will be assessed on the content of Modules 4 and 5 of the Studio text book.
