Listening, Reading and Writing skills will be assessed. Each skill has equal weighting.



Listenina

The Listening skill exam will take place during a class <u>before</u> the start of the school exams. You will have to do a range of exercises including multiple choice, true or false, matching pairs, ticking boxes, filling in grids, giving information in English etc. For this skill you will need to *recognise* spoken French and communicate your understanding and recognition of it.



Your reading skills will be assessed as part of the timetabled exams. You will have to do a range of exercises including multiple choice, true or false, matching pairs, ticking boxes, filling in grids, giving information in English etc. For this skill you will need to *recognise* written French and communicate your understanding and recognition of it.

Writing

Your writing skills will be assessed as part of the timetabled exams. You will have to write sentences in French for headings provided and write a longer paragraph. You need to be able to *use* and write your French accurately.

Content

You will be assessed on the content of Modules 4 and 5 of the Studio text book.

Module 4 will be assessed for LISTENING AND WRITING skills. Module 5 will be assessed for LISTENING AND READING skills.
