Year 9 Geography Revision Checklist

Learning outcomes are listed at the start of each Geography booklet and identified at the relevant point within the booklet. The following are the topics and learning outcomes you should revise for your May assessment.

Topic 1 – Geology, Weathering and Erosion

- 1. I can name the three families into which rocks are classified.
- 2. I can explain how rocks are formed within each of these three families.
- 3. I can identify the following: basalt, granite, limestone, sandstone, marble, slate.
- 4. I can name for each of these rocks the family to which it belongs and I can describe its colour, use and location.
- 5. I can name the rivers, loughs and mountains of N.I.

Topic 2 – Ordnance Survey

- 1. I can read each of the three types of scale found on OS maps.
- 2. I can use the scale on a map to measure the straight line distance between two places.
- 3. I can use the scale on a map to measure the actual distance between two places.
- 4. I can define what is meant by contour lines and explain how they have been drawn.
- 5. I can use contour lines to describe the general height and shape of the land.
- 6. I can recognise and read layer shading and spot heights on an OS map.

Topic 3 – LEDC Settlement

- 1. I can recall what the letters LEDC stand for.
- 2. I can define the term subsistence agriculture and describe the characteristics of a subsistence farm.
- 3. I can define the term push factors and give examples of push factors operating in LEDCs.
- 4. I can define the term pull factors and give examples of pull factors operating in LEDCs.
- 5. I can explain what is meant by internal migration and describe the main type of internal migration in LEDCs.
- 6. I can draw a simple model showing the main land uses in a LEDC city.
