The Year 9 exam consists of a short Listening Paper, taken in class time before the main exams because it is a practical listening test.

I CAN:

- Identify Note letter names (lines and spaces)
- Identify Note lengths/types (crotchets, minims etc)
- Identify the names and meanings of the **elements of music**, as they will appear in the listening questions.
eg Describe the **tempo** of this music.
- Listen to the instruments of the orchestra at <https://philharmonia.co.uk/resources/instruments/> to help you with general listening and identifying instruments.
- Recognise Beat in the bar eg 3 beats in the bar, 4 beats in the bar.
- Understand the term Ostinato. Recognise pitched and un-pitched Ostinati and which instruments are playing them
- Understand the meaning of 'motif' and 'pentatonic'.
- Be able to identify structure/form in a piece of music using the letters A, B, C, etc for the different sections as they come along or repeat.
