• Identify Note letter names (lines and spaces)

• Identify the names and meanings of the elements of music , as they will appear in the listening questions. eg Describe the tempo of this music.		
• Listen to the instruments of the orchestra at <u>https://philharmonia.co.uk/resources/instruments/</u> to help you with general listening and identifying insruments.		
 Recognise Beat in the bar eg 3 beats in the bar, 4 beats in the bar. Understand the term Ostinato. Recognise pitched and un-pitched Ostinati and which instruments are playing them Understand the meaning of 'motif' and 'pentatonic'. 		
• Be able to identify structure/form in a piece of music using the letters A, B, C, etc for the different sections as they come along or repeat.
