

Subject : MUSIC YEAR 9

The Year 9 exam consists of a Listening Paper and a Performance both taken in class time before the main exams.

Each part is worth 50% of the exam.

I CAN:

- Identify Note letter names (lines and spaces)

- Identify Note lengths/types (crotchets, minims etc)

- Identify the names and meanings of all the **elements of music**, as they will appear in the listening questions.
eg Describe the **tempo** of this music.

- Listen to the instruments of the orchestra at <https://philharmonia.co.uk/resources/instruments/> to help you with general listening.

- Recognise Beat in the bar;
- Recognise pitched and un-pitched Ostinati and which instruments are playing them

- Recognise the meaning and use of Motif and Pentatonic Scale

- Be able to identify structure/form in a piece of music using the letters A, B, C, etc for the different sections as they come along or repeat.

- Practise my ukulele test piece through steadily, without stopping and without making a mistake. *It does not have to be played fast, but smoothly and accurately.* The test piece on Ukulele is Swing Low.
